Commissioner D'Agostino announced approval of the May 23, 2025, Election Board meeting minutes.

**ELECTION BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 10 OF 2025**

**WHEREAS**, at a public meeting on Wednesday, October 1, 2025, the Lancaster County Board of Elections approved posting notification of proposed polling place changes effective with the November 4, 2025 Municipal Election, and of a hearing to be held in the Commissioners' Public Meeting Room on October 7, 2025, at the 11:00 a.m. Board of Elections meeting.

**Update on the November 4, 2025, General Election**

Christa Miller, Chief Clerk/Chief Registrar

Christa Miller reported that there are 359,439 registered voters for the upcoming election and 29,733 mail-in ballot requests to date. She noted that ballots will be mailed out next week. The voter registration deadline is October 20, 2025, at midnight, with the Voter Registration Office open until 5:00 p.m. that day. The mail-in ballot application deadline is October 28, 2025, at 5:00 p.m., and the office will begin accepting completed ballots on October 14, 2025.

In response to Commissioner D'Agostino, Christa stated that recent state rulings do not affect Lancaster County's election process.

Commissioner Parsons asked clarifying questions regarding the timeline for mailing out mail-in ballots and how residents can request and return a mail-in ballot at the Voter Registration Office.


Christa responded to Commissioner Yoder's questions about measures implemented to reduce common voter errors, such as changing the color of the privacy envelope.

Commissioner Yoder and Christa discussed how and when voters receive notifications. Christa explained that voters may choose to provide a phone number and/or an email address when completing their mail-in ballot application, which determines how they receive notifications. She noted that these notifications are managed through the SURE system.

On motion of Commissioner Parsons, seconded by Commissioner Yoder, the meeting adjourned at 11:13 a.m.
