

COVID-19 Safety Guidelines for the Lancaster County Swimming Pool

1. Maintenance staff will be sanitizing the facility daily. Pool staff will be sanitizing "high touch" areas (sink and toilet handles, doorknobs, etc.) throughout the day.
2. The following CDC sign in both English and Spanish will be posted throughout the Pool complex to provide patrons guidelines for using the Pool safely.

FOLLOW THESE 5 SAFETY STEPS to keep us all healthy

1 STAY HOME IF YOU DON'T FEEL WELL
Or if you tested positive for COVID-19 or were exposed to someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days



2 STAY 6 FEET AWAY FROM PEOPLE
who don't live with you, both in and out of the water and avoid sharing items with other people



3 WEAR A CLOTH FACE COVERING
when not in the water*

* Don't place cloth face coverings on children under age 2 or anyone who has trouble breathing or is unconscious, weak, or otherwise unable to remove the cover without help.



4 WASH YOUR HANDS OFTEN with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol



5 COVER YOUR COUGHS AND SNEEZES
with a tissue or your elbow, throw the tissue in the trash, and wash your hands

3. **Patrons are expected to wear mask when entering the Pool complex.** As indicated on the CDC signs, once inside the Pool complex masks will be advised but not required as this is in an outdoor environment where social distancing can be maintained. *(Note: Wearing masks in the water will be prohibited as they create a drowning risk.)*
4. Shielding will be placed at the cash register and Pool Front Desk where staff most frequently interact with customers, and desk staff will be encouraged to wear masks. Due to the potential health hazards with wearing masks for prolonged periods in hot temperatures, we cannot require that all staff wear them.
5. Per aquatic industry safety standards, lifeguards will not wear masks.
6. Restroom entrances and exits will be designated to create one-way traffic.
7. We will utilize the sound system at the Pool to frequently remind patrons of the safety guidelines.
