**10 ACRES**

<b>PARKING</b>	Vehicles must be parked in the cul-de-sac. Parking at sites is not permitted. No sleeping in vehicles except in cases of extreme weather. <b>We cannot accommodate RVs or pop-up campers of any kind.</b>
<b>RESTROOMS</b>	There is a port-o-pot in the cul-de-sac. There are no shower facilities.
<b>TRASH</b>	Please take all trash with you or dispose of it in the barrels provided in the cul-de-sac. Practice "leave no trace" principles.
<b>WATER</b>	There are two public use potable water spigots near sites 3 and 5.
<b>ELECTRIC</b>	There is <b>no electric</b> at this campground, including lighting. Plan to have your tent set up before sundown.
<b>CHECK IN/OUT</b>	You can arrive at your site as early as 1pm. Check out is 12pm. Check your permit for the dates & times you have reserved.
<b>FIRES</b>	Fires are only permitted in the provided fire rings. You may bring your own firewood or gather it from around the campground (collect dead wood only; do not cut any standing trees or use a chainsaw). <b>Fires must be completely extinguished before leaving!</b> Do not leave any smoking or burning embers unattended to.
<b>QUIET HOURS</b>	11pm-7am
<b>PETS</b>	Pets are permitted and must be leashed within the campground at all times.

# About

Mill Creek Camping Area is a ten acre campground with five primitive sites for tent camping located in Lancaster County Central Park, two miles south of downtown Lancaster.



# Reservations

- A reservation is required to camp. Please call or visit the Parks Office to reserve.
- Each site accommodates up to eight people.
- Maximum stay is limited to six consecutive nights followed by a six night absence before returning.
- Camping is permitted **April 1-October 31**.

# Rules & Regulations

- The park is **closed from dusk to dawn**. Campers must stay within the campground unless leaving or entering the park during this time.
- **Alcohol is strictly prohibited.**



Campers must abide by all park rules and regulations. Scan the QR for the complete park rules and regulations, or find them posted on any park kiosk.

# Things to Do In Central Park

- Central Park is a 544 acre park with over 13 miles of mixed use **hiking trails**. Scan the QR below for a trail guide.
- **Fishing** is permitted in the Mill Creek and Conestoga River with a fishing license.
- **Lancaster County Pool** is open 7 days a week for most of the summer. Check our website for pool hours and admission prices.
- The **tennis courts, basketball court, skatepark, and playground** are open to the public from dawn to dusk.
- Enjoy **natural and historic areas** including the Muhlenburg Native Wildflower Meadow, the Garden of Five Senses, and the Archaeological Site.
- Check out nature books or field guides from **Shuts Environmental Library** with a Lancaster County library card.


